

Journal of Plant Research (JPR) | Pre-submission checklist

General
The study falls within the Scope of the Journal.
All figures, tables, and supplementary materials are cited and numbered in the consecutive order in which they appear in the text.
The cover letter includes all necessary information. (see Manuscript Preparation)
The manuscript follows the Typographical Rules specific to JPR. Below are common pitfalls:
Statistics: Italicize P and R^2 and insert a space before and after equal and inequality signs. (e.g. $P = 0.01$, $P < 0.001$, $R^2 = 0.85$; but not $P = 0.01$)
□ Volume: do not mix L and I; use one or the other. (e.g. 1.2 L, 1.2 mL; but not 1.2 L, 1.2 ml)
 In-text citations: cite multiple references in alphabetical order, but not in chronological order. (e.g. Abbott 2015; Barakat et al. 2010; Coleman 2020)
Manuscript
Cover page (the 1st page of the manuscript) includes:
Corresponding author (full name, email address, affiliation, city and country)
 Subject area (select from the list in <u>Manuscript Preparation</u>) Number of tables, number of figures
Title page (the 2nd page of the manuscript) includes:
□ Title
□ All authors' information
□ Abstract (< 300 words)
□ Keywords (4 to 6 keywords, arranged in alphabetical order)
! Please ensure the correct author group, the Corresponding Author, and the order of authors at the
initial submission. Changes to authorship at a later stage are generally not permitted.
Text (the subsequent pages of the manuscript) includes:
□ Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion
□ Acknowledgments (optional)
Competing Interests (*mandatory)
 References Tables (tables may be prepared and submitted in a separate file)
Figures (see Artwork and Illustration Guidelines)
Additional instructions for JPR:
□ Figure panel: Use boldfaced lowercase a , b , c , without parentheses
Axis titles of a graph: Only the first letter is capitalized. (e.g. "Fresh weight", but not "Fresh Weight")
<u>Supplementary information</u>
Additional instructions for JPR:
□ Numbering: Figure (Fig. S1, Fig. S2); Table (Table S1, Table S2,); Data (Supplementary Data 1, Supplementary Data 2)
 Include the following information at the top of each file: article title, journal name, author names, affiliation, and e-mail address of the corresponding author.
□ Compile multiple figures and tables into one PDF whenever possible. Include a legend at the bottom of each figure and at the top of each table.
