The Editors of *Esophagus* receive and review manuscripts on the following conditions.

- 1. The contents have not been published elsewhere.
- 2. If the authors submit material which has been published in whole or in part, in a language other than English, all the conditions in "Acceptable Secondary Publication" in Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals (N Engl J Med 1997;336:309–315, or available at the websites www.nejm.org or www.thelancet.com) should be met. Written permission from the editors and copyright holder of the primary publication, and four reprints or photocopies of the primary publication should be submitted together. All figures and tables must be redrawn or rewritten. Information
- regarding the original source of the publication must be indicated clearly in a footnote on the first page.
- 3. The manuscript is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- 4. All the authors had a significant part in the work and approved the final version of the manuscript.
- 5. Investigations in humans are in accordance with the ethical standards of the responsible committee (institutional or regional) or with the Helsinki Declaration.
- Studies of animal experiments include a statement in the Materials section that all animals received humane care in compliance with the guidelines of the authors' institution or the National Research Council's criteria (NIH publication No. 86-23).
