	The word count and the number of figures and tables do not exceed the limit.
	The main manuscript text, table(s), and figure(s) are prepared in separate files.
	Permission is obtained for any copyrighted material included in the manuscript (figures, tables, or text passages that have been published elsewhere), and the original source is appropriately credited. Permission for both the print and online format is required. (Further guidance is available here .)
1. The manuscript file (in MS Word format)	
	Lines and pages are numbered sequentially from the first page.
	Double-spacing is used throughout the text.
	The <u>rules for animal and plant name descriptions</u> are correctly followed.
	Title page
	☐ The title conforms to the standard specified in the " <u>Title of Your Work</u> " section.
	☐ The <u>author information</u> is correct and final. Please ensure the author group, the Corresponding Author, and the order of authors are correct at submission. (For further guidance, see <u>Authorship principles</u> .)
	☐ A ZooBank note is provided if your study involves a nomenclatural act.
	$\hfill\Box$ The word count for the main text, excluding the reference list, is provided.
	☐ The number of figures and the number of tables are provided.
	Abstract: the length is between 150 and 250 words.

	References are cited in the name-year style and listed in alphabetical order.
	Citations in the text correspond with the reference list.
	Figure legends are grouped at the end of the text file, after the reference list.
2. Table(s) (in MS Word format)	
	<u>Tables</u> are prepared using the table function in Word; they are not included as spreadsheets.
	All tables are numbered and cited in the text in sequential order.
3. Figure(s)	
	All figures are numbered and cited in the text in sequential order.
	Figure quality is sufficient for publication and all information in the figure is legible. The resolution of your image may have been reduced during processing or file conversion.
	Figure legends are NOT included in the figure file, but in the text file.
4. Supplementary information	
	All supplementary materials are numbered and cited in the text in sequential order.
