Please observe the following guidelines for your article.

Text

- Save your contribution as a Word document or as a LaTeX document. For your LaTeX document, please use the Springer Nature LaTeX authoring template available from https://www.springernature.com/gp/authors/campaigns/latex-author-support. Please send the original source file (including all your style files and figures) and a PDF version of the compiled LaTeX file.
- Divide your text into hierarchically numbered sub-chapters. Apart from this, no special formatting is necessary.
- You can write your article in German or in English.
- The length of the article should not exceed 3000 words including bibliography.

Contribution

Please enter the following information on the first page of your contribution:

- Title of the article (German and English)
- All authors (please write their first names in full)
- Affiliation of all authors (company or university)
- Contact details of the corresponding author: name, postal address, email address

Please note the following when selecting a corresponding author:

Any free open access arrangements (e.g., university affiliation) apply only to the corresponding author and cannot be handled by one of the other coauthors.

- Abstract (German)
- Abstract (English)
- Keywords (German)
- Keywords (English)

Please note that the title, abstract, and keywords must be in both English and German.

You may add acknowledgements, if any, at the end of your article.

References

Please use the style "Springer - MathPhys (numeric, brackets)" for your references. The common reference managers have this style available in their style repositories. This style refers to your sources with numbers in square brackets ([1], [2], [3], etc.) and adds the references at the end of your paper. The order of the sources corresponds to the order within your paper and is not an alphabetical order.

Please make sure that you have the following information complete in your reference manager, depending on the type of reference (book or journal):

For books: Author(s), title, year, publisher, place of publication
For journals: additionally volume number, issue number, and exact page references, DOI (if available)
For internet pages: url and date of access

Figures and tables
