

Guidelines for Authors of *Journal of Water Chemistry and Technology*

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Subject Matter

Journal of Water Chemistry and Technology publishes new and original scientific theoretical and experimental articles on the following topical problems:

- New in water science;
- New in the science of natural phenomena;
- Theoretical foundations of technology and treatment of water;
- Physical chemistry of water treatment processes;
- Analytical chemistry of water;
- Water treatment technology and water demineralization;
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- Ecological safety of the hydrosphere.

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Critical reviews should summarize the results of recent research (no more than 20 pages, no more than 40–50 references).

The author should submit along with the manuscript:

- The Copyright Transfer Agreements and Guarantees on the Part of the Authors, completed and signed by the author and all co-authors (see appendix);
- A cover letter from the author, and for collective works, a letter from the author responsible for correspondence; The cover letter can be sent both in paper and electronic (print, sign, scan) form.
- Information about the authors: full name, name of institution, its postal address, city, country, and zip code, contact information (phone number, e-mail address). The corresponding author should be indicated;
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The main text of the manuscript should be structured as follows:

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Experimental.

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Conclusions contain the main results of the work.
